#### Management Report

Madison Avenue Presbyterian Church ended 2004 with a small operating surplus thanks to the generosity of many of you at year end. As the year unfolded, it became very clear that we had not allocated enough funds for repairs and maintenance to the Church House as the water and sewage systems required significant repairs due to their aging condition. Some of these repairs were postponed due to lack of funds and to the anticipated replacement of the Church House infrastructure beginning the summer of 2005. In addition, the batteries providing emergency lighting for the sanctuary reached the end of their useful life and had to be replaced at a cost of over \$10,000. Our property and liability insurance premiums continue to rise significantly, so to moderate this increase, we decided to maintain the value of the property at its currently insured value and raised the deductible from \$5,000 to \$25,000. A new fire alarm system was installed in the Phillips Building, significantly increasing its safety. The mission and ministries of MAPC continued to grow with several new program initiatives, including a five-day a week overnight shelter for the homeless, an expanded Kids' Club program, and a new worship program for children ages 2 through 4.

#### Additional highlights include the following:

- The total value of the Endowment Funds declined minimally from \$21.5 to \$21.4 MM with the withdrawal of \$1.35 MM for support of the operating and capital budgets. Our money manager continues to commit significant funds to overseas investments, both stocks and bonds, and to the materials and energy sectors of the economy.
- Our line of credit with the Bank of New York for the Fund for Renewal projects decreased by \$300,000 from \$2.5 MM to \$2.2 MM.
- Total dollars pledged to MAPC increased from \$917,524 in 2003 to \$991,539 in 2004. During this time, the number of pledging units has remained very constant in the mid-330s, about 50% of total pledging units in the congregation. So far in 2005, we have received 263 pledges totaling \$944,138. We almost reached our pledges collection goal of \$1.0 MM due to many members contributing more than their pledges. Even so, about \$37,000 in pledges were unfulfilled at year end. Fees Use of Facilities income exceeded budget due to the strong demand for space from neighboring private schools, coop and condo boards, and various other groups. Non-Recurring Income exceeded budget due to a significant and unexpected year end gift.
- In general, personnel and program expenses were less than budget. An external heat timer enabled us to better manage our energy usage and thereby lessen the impact of significantly higher energy costs. At year end, architectural and engineering planning fees were moved from operations to construction-in-progress due to the now approved capital projects in the Church House.
- Almost \$35,000 dollars was received through five bequests as you will note on the Bequests and Capital Improvements Schedule (p.10). This schedule also reports capital improvements charged to the annual operating budget, the Fund for Renewal and the Day School as well as several projects in progress.

- The Special Funds report that follows shows the activity in these funds. Funds collected totaling \$61,482 for September 11 were finally distributed primarily to New York Disaster Interfaith Services, a major faith-based agency operating in response to the continuing needs of September 11. A description of the various funds follows the Schedule of Special Funds Receipts and Disbursements report.
- The Schedule of Fund for Renewal Receipts and Disbursements shows that we received over \$291,000 in Fund for Renewal income from the collection of pledges and receipt of bequests. A grant of \$100,000 was distributed to the Harlem Congregation for Community Improvement completing the mission grants for the Fund for Renewal. A significant uncollected receivable remains in the Fund for Renewal and will need to be address more rigorously this year.
- The Day School continues to thrive under the leadership of Pat Pell as director and Ann McChord as chair of the Day School Committee. 99 students are enrolled for the current school year.
- The Day School had another very successful year with its fund raising activities generating almost \$383,000 in income. These funds were used for tuition aid, installation of children's restrooms in two classrooms, and for support of the general operations of the school. About 20% of the operating budget needs to be raised through fund raising each year.

Thank you for your faithful and generous support during this past year, which enables the Madison Avenue Presbyterian Church to be here for each of you, our children and families, our community, the homeless and less fortunate, and the world. The new year holds much promise of growth and development of ministry and mission, of improved facilities, of opportunities for generous giving, and of responding to the unanticipated needs of our local, national and world communities. As you have received, may you also give.

#### Flower Fund

Donations received from individuals for memorial flowers. Chancel committee purchases flowers for the church services.

#### Interim Deposits

Funds received for a specific purpose are deposited and disbursed from this account.

#### Joey Trout Fund

Donations received from friends and colleagues of the Trouts to pay for Joey Trout's medical expenses.

#### Special Mission Offerings

Contributions received in support of relief efforts following catastrophic events around the world, including the September 11 Fund.

#### Memorial Funds

Donations received in lieu of flowers in memory of deceased members. Funds accumulate and are used at the discretion of the Session.

#### Minnie Parker Fund

Minnie Parker Charitable Trust grants to be used for Christian Education or to assist children in attending summer camp.

#### David G. Price Fund for Adult Christian Education

This Fund supports MAPC's adult Christian education programs.

### David G. Price Fund for Congregational Self-Help

This Fund supports MAPC's congregation self-help programs.

#### **Emergency Mission Fund**

Fund established by Session from part of 1997 Peacemaking Offering for emergency mission projects.

#### Reserve for Pastoral Services

Gifts donated for special needs and used at the discretion of Session and pastors. Funded primarily by income from a Kim Keeley trust.

#### St. Andrew's Music Society

Funds are received by contributions and donation at concerts. Funds are disbursed for concert musicians and publicity.

#### St. Andrew's Chamber Music

Donations received at chamber music concerts and disbursed to performing musicians less any copyright fees.

#### Seniors Unlimited

Funds collected and disbursed for trips and other activities for senior citizens.

#### Weddings & Funerals

Fees paid for organists, soloists, instrumentalists, etc. at weddings and funerals and then disbursed to same.

#### Youth Library

Donations, payment of fines and sale of books used for purchase of new books.

#### Columbarium Fund

Funds received for columbarium niches and related expenses.

#### Read Scholarship Fund

Temporary fund used to track income and expenses of the Read Scholarship Fund. Quarterly income and expenses are netted and debited or credited to the Read Scholarship Fund investment fund, which is part of the General Endowment Fund.

#### General Endowment Fund

Unrestricted investment fund for the general operating purposes of the Church. \$550,926 of the Fund is permanently restricted as of December 31, 2004.

#### Cutter Fund

Restricted investment fund received in 1939 from the estate of Bertha Kauffmann Cutter. Income is to be used for the relief of the poor and the needy of the Church. \$193,280 of the Fund is permanently restricted.

#### Luce Fund

Initial grant of \$225,000 from the Henry Luce Foundation for the day-to-day operating expenses of the Church. The grantor stipulates that none of the income shall be used for the Mission and Benevolence program of the Church.

#### Creasy Fund

Bequest of \$145,748, which is permanently restricted, from the estate of Caroline E. Creasy received from 1992 - 1994. Bequest is invested in the General Endowment Fund and income is to be used for the Mission Outreach Program of the Church.
