You must then average your MP1, MP2 and MP3 grades ((MP1 + MP2 + MP3)/3) and enter your FINAL, MP4 grades under MP4 in the pull down menu. Make sure you save this as well.

Please note that the <u>MP4</u> grade is what appears on the transcript as the grade for the Spring term.

The only allowable grades are:

NS: ONLY USED FOR LTAs. Pass/Fail equivalent of Fail or numeric equivalent of 45.

NL:

"New or Recent Admit" is awarded to student who enroll in a course after it has started and may have missed assignments or assessments needed to generate a complete course grade for a given marking period. These students must successfully complete remaining course requirements by the end of the semester following the termination of the course in order to receive a final grade and credit, as applicable.

Please keep in mind there have been several program changes and students may have been switched into your class recently. Please ask these new students if they were in a different class and communicate with prior teachers, where possible, to determine a fair grade for the marking period.

55: The <u>only</u> numeric failing grade is a grade of **55.** The student did not meet the standards required to pass the class. This grade should be given to students who have <u>not</u> demonstrated mastery of the material for a passing grade of 65 or better.

60: For the 1st 5 Marking Periods only. **O NOT GIVE A GRADE OF 60 AS A FINAL GRADE!**

P/F: Lab courses and service.

65 - 85: Used in multiples of five only (65, 70, 75, etc.) for passing students.

86 - 100: May be in increments of 1 (86, 87, 88, etc.)

PLEASE NOTE:

The only allowable grades are NS, NL, P, F, 55, 65-85 in increments of 5, 86-100
